ATTENDANCE MONITORING

Just a reminder that we open the classroom doors at 8.30am to welcome the children. Registration is at 8.50am and doors will be closed at this time. We want to encourage punctuality and help ensure pupils have a calm start to their day. If your child arrives after 8.50am they will need to come through the main school entrance.

We ask that parents of EYFS pupils say goodbye to pupils at the classroom door now that our youngest children are showing increased independence and confidence.

A new attendance policy is now in operation and can be found on our website along with an information leaflet for parents. Attendance is monitored on a weekly basis and parents of any pupil with low attendance will be invited to meet with the class teacher in the first instance. If attendance does not then improve they will be invited to meet with the Head of School and following on from this our Education Welfare Officer will make contact.

Non urgent medical appointments need to be arranged outside school times. We understand that there are times when children need to attend hospital appointments scheduled during the school day and this is unavoidable.
