



<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Children will continue to take part in daily phonic lessons, consolidating their phase 2 and 3 sounds and learning new phase 4 sounds to read simple stories. In literacy sessions children will apply their phonic knowledge to write sentences, captions, short stories and lists.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Expressive arts and design</u></p> <p>Children will continue to learn how to use the Art/ DT areas of the classroom and outdoor environment safely.</p> <p>Children will design and create junk model castles and explore animation with a focus on Walt Disney.</p> <p>Children will create pictures with moving parts</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Personal, social and emotional development</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Building relationships: My family and friends</p> <p>In this unit, children will learn how we all have different beliefs and celebrations, what characteristics make a good friend, and how we need to listen to one another.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>This half term, children will work with numbers beyond 10, learning the counting order up to 20 and noticing simple number patterns.</p> <p>They will also build on their addition skills by exploring how amounts increase when more is added, working securely within numbers to 10.</p> <p>In shape work, children will move from using 3D shapes for a purpose to exploring 2D shapes— naming them, describing their features, and using them in practical activities.</p>
