<u>Geography:</u> <u>What is it like here?</u> We will learn about the geography of where we live and the local Area. <u>English</u> We will secure correct letter formation and handwriting skills through writing a range of lists and captions based around our immersion of traditional tales such as Goldilocks and the Three Bears, The Gingerbread Man.	<u>PE</u> <u>Footwork</u> The children will develop and apply their footwork and one leg balance through focused thematic stories, songs and games. <u>Running and moving</u> The children will develop experiment with different running techniques and begin to understand how to run as fast as possible.	<u>Music</u> <u>Hey You!</u> As musicians, we will learn to sing, play, improvise and compose with this HipHop song.	<u>Maths</u> Our Maths learning this term will focus on: <u>Place Value</u> As mathematicians, we will learn to sort, recognise, count and compare numbers and objects to 10.
<u>PSHE</u> <u>Me and My Relationships</u> The children will learn about the importance of classroom rules, our own and others' feelings and friendship.	<u>DT</u> <u>Textiles: Puppets</u> As engineers, we will be learning to design and make a hand puppet by joining two pieces of material together without sewing.
