### Important Information about the School Day

Since the start of term, we have no longer had staggered drop off or collection times, helping to increase our curriculum time for the benefit of the children's learning.

Our school day officially begins at 8:50am so all pupils need to be inside their class before 8:50am each day. On an occasion when you arrive late, please escort your child into school through the main school entrance for **late registration**. Any arrivals after 9.00am is classed as an unauthorised absence and will be coded accordingly.
