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## Reading books

Later this week the children will take home a reading book. Due to the current situation the children will only have 1 schoolbook each week. The children are also encouraged to read own books from home if they finish the school reading book. Please keep a note of when you have read with your child in their reading record book. Staff will be checking reading record books on a Friday.

## Homework

In Key Stage 1 we use the remote learning platform Google Classroom. This is a wonderful forum to build communication between learners, parents, and teachers. When you have completed any activity set, please either take a photo of your work and upload to Google Classroom or write task completed in the comments section. We will use this platform for homework, which will be uploaded weekly, on Fridays. Please contact the office if you need to access your child's home learning via an alternative method. After half term, we will introduce spelling homework also. The children are asked to read their school reading book/home book 5 nights a week. The children will also receive weekly Maths homework through Sumdog and Numbots which will reinforce concepts taught in the week. After half term, children will have spellings set on here too. Details and logins for access to each of these sites, will be sent home this week or may have already reached you.

## Behaviour

Last week you will have received a letter providing you with login details to view and track your child's Dojo rewards. Once logged in you will be able to see the reason behind their reward(s) and then talk to your child about this positive event.
