We have received some concerning reports regarding parking and speed on Chapel Road. Parents and children have had some 'near misses' due to having to cross between parked cars and negotiating speeding vehicles. Please could we ask that you are considerate when parking and driving along this road. We are also aware that this area is used for parking and walking dogs!

We have also witnessed cars trying to turn around just inside the vehicular entrance to the school from William Hosking Road. This is causing the risk of a road traffic accident and endangering pedestrians entering school from the direction of Quintrell Downs. It needs to stop. Please use the one-way system. The staff car park has a limited number of disabled spaces for pupils or parents with a blue badge, including a drop-off zone. All other parents and carers should use the parking along the edges of the one-way driveway or at the bottom end of the school grounds. If you are moving around on foot, for your own safety we ask you to please use the footpaths including the footpath around the edge of the staff car park. Thank you.
