Covid-19 Arrangements Updates

Devices - We have received a few more devices from the DFE but they are rightly prioritising secondary schools at this time. Please contact us if you are struggling with digital access and we can discuss possible solutions with you.

Testing of Staff - Next week we expect delivery of Lateral flow tests for staff. We will then commence testing of staff 2 x weekly. This will help reduce the chance of an asymptomatic adult in school transmitting the virus to others attending at this time. More info on this to follow.

Please make sure we have the correct emergency phone number for you even if your child is currently with you at home. If we call at an inconvenient time and you are unable to answer, we ask you to call us back later the same day if you are able to do so.
