# Reporting a Positive Case over the Christmas holidays.

Important guidance for parents/carers relating to reporting positive cases over the Christmas holidays:

For the first 6 days after the end of school, if a pupil tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, please use the Aspire reporting form at www.aspireacademytrust.org/coronavirus as the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school. This includes any days up to and including Christmas Eve.

Where a pupil tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms **more than** 48 hours since being in school, the school should **NOT** be contacted (until the first day of the new term). Parents and carers should instead follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

School staff are NOT asked to remain oncall or conduct any contact tracing after Christmas Eve (6 days after the final day at school).

# Applying for a September 2021 School Place for a child in Reception

If your child was born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017, you will need to apply for a school place for September 2021. **The deadline is 15 January 2021**.

Skol Nansledan has so much to offer your child and we want you to be fully informed when making this important decision.




