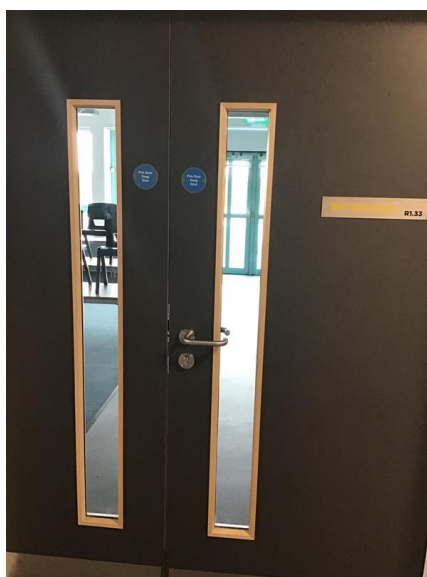

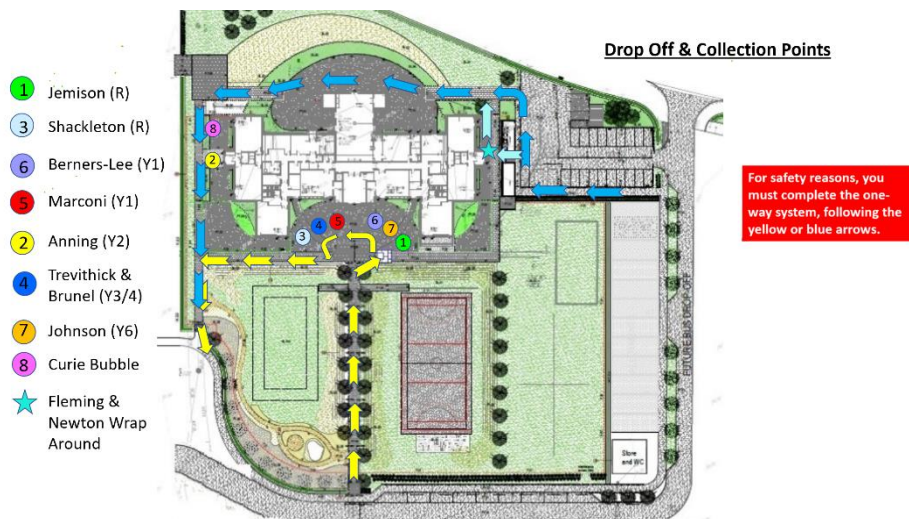
The other adult in my room will be:
