Parking & Pick Up Time

Since we reverted back to our normal school day finish time of 3:15pm, traffic congestion and parking difficulties have been a real concern. A number of you have contacted school to pass on your concerns and to ask about whether there are plans to add additional parking.

We have already approached both our Estates team and the Duchy for discussions about how to increase our parking capacity and any plans for increased local parking that could be utilised by parents. None of these changes will happen in the short term but conversations will be ongoing and we will keep you informed.

Staggered pick-up times were brought in as a Covid-19 infection control measure but resulted in a loss of teaching time across school daily. Prior to Covid, our collection time was always 3:15pm for all classes. In the meantime, our school has grown and perhaps a greater proportion of families are now travelling to school by car.

We are now considering changing the format of the school day for pupils in KS1 and EYFS (Reception – Year 2) to explore if it is possible to enable an earlier pick up for these pupils. We will update you in due course.

In the meantime, please know, we will supervise your children safely if you are ever tied up in the traffic. We don't want to add to anyone's stress and will always ensure children are supervised by staff and are well looked after while they wait for you.
