Free School Meal Eligibility

During the past 12 months, the circumstances of some families may have changed. If you think this may apply to you, you may be entitled to Free School Meals. This is not to be confused with the Universal Infant Free School meals for all KS1 children. Free School meal eligibility brings in vital Pupil Premium funding for schools. A child is eligible for Free School Meals if their parent/carer (or the child themselves in their own right) receives any of the following benefits:

- Income Support (IS)
- Job Seekers' Allowance (Income-Based) and equal based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA-IR) and equal based Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income of less than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Guarantee Element of Pension Credit (GPC)
- Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA) Support
- Universal Credit - Your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get) as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods

Football Roadshows

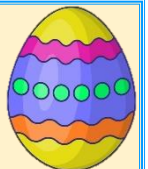
Easter Holiday Football Roadshows are being held at Treviglas Community College on Tuesday 6th and 13th April. Please take a look at the link below if you are interested.
