Safety of the community continues to be our top priority at this time. Many of you have passed on messages of appreciation for the safety measures in place and Remote Learning provision. Hopefully these things will help to limit the impact of this illness on our school community.

With this in mind, we encourage those of you who haven't already received your vaccinations to now do so. Additionally, please follow the procedures if your child or any member of your household exhibits symptoms.

Anyone with symptoms needs to book a PCR test and the rest of the household and childcare bubble should isolate.

The main symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are:

- a **high temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a **new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a **loss or change to your sense of smell or taste** – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Please continue to follow our procedures and all of the government guidelines. Let's work together to keep each other safe and see an end to this situation.
